

## MAXIMUM OCCUPANT LOAD

FOR Breton Community Centre

(specify room/area name and building name)

Community Hall

Alberta Fire Code 2006, Division "B" Article 2.7.1.3

- 1) The maximum permissible occupant load for any room shall be calculated on the basis of the lesser of
- a) The number of occupants determined in accordance with Table 3.1.17.1 Division B of the Alberta Building Code 2006,
  - b) The occupant load for which means of egress are provided, or
  - c) The occupant load as calculated and posted in accordance with the Alberta Building Code 2006.
- 2) The number of occupants permitted to enter a room shall not exceed the posted maximum occupant load calculated in conformance with Sentence (1).

See Sentence 2.7.1.5. of the Alberta Fire Code 2006 which specifies the required aisle and row arrangements.
