Breton FCSS would like to ask the Breton Ag Society if they would be interested in partnering on a Community Easter Egg Hunt. This event would be held near the Easter Weekend of April 2 - 5. It would resemble the one held in Warburg with the following format:

- Numerous plastic eggs are filled with foiled chocolate eggs
- Volunteers scatter the eggs in a defined area - possibly the RV park
- Community members of all ages are divided into age groups and given a short period of time and a maximum amount of eggs that they can gather. Following all the groups if there are still eggs out, it is a free for all.
- If possible businesses can donate to the event and additional prizes are give out (i.e. gift baskets, restaurant coupons, gift cards, bikes). These are awarded by placing tickets inside of some of the eggs
- Snacks such as bags of chips and juice boxes could also be distributed.

We would like to partner with a group to hold a community event this spring. We feel that it would be a good moral booster if something could be held that gets people outside in a social atmosphere within Covid guidelines. This would be a free event but if participants wanted to make a donation it could be to the Ag Society.

Breton FCSS would purchase the plastic eggs and the chocolate eggs. Promotion of the event and advertising. The event would be promoted as a joint event between the Breton Ag Society and Breton FCSS. We would need assistance with:

- Filling eggs
- Scattering eggs
- Organizing age groups
- Announcing the day of the event
- Distributing snacks if offered
- Gathering additional prizes
